The Troop's next outing is a snowshoe day hike to Annette Lake, which is about 5 miles west of Snoqualmie Pass. This 7.5 mile roundtrip hike with 1,400' of elevation gain is open to all Scouts regardless of rank or age. Webelos Scouts and their parents are also invited to attend and sample our high quality Scouting program. A day pack containing at least the 10 essentials is helpful, good boots are encouraged, layers of clothing for adjustable warmth are ideal, and **Rain Gear is a must**. Scouts should plan a sack lunch and the Troop will provide hot water for your hot drink or soup mix.

Scouts are to meet at West Side Presbyterian Church on Saturday, February 11th at 8am.
Scouts will be returned to the church around 4pm the same day.

The fee for this trip is \$5 (Webelos Scouts and their parents are free).
Portable electronic devices (iPod, CD players, radios, etc.) are not allowed (cameras are fine).

Driving Directions: From Seattle drive east on I-90 to exit 47 (Asahel Curtis/Denny Creek). Turn right from the off-ramp and continue 0.25 mile, then turn left on Forest Road 5590. You'll find the parking area in 0.3 mile.
